SKI INJURY STATISTICS

Seven years of studies of ski injuries have led to the conclusions that ski injuries are related to individual skier ability, sex and age. The likelihood of injury decreases with advancing age and with greater skiing ability. Women have injury rates nearly twice those of men of comparable ability. The types of injuries suffered are about the same for skiers of either sex and of varying abilities. So, if you are a young woman novice skier, be careful!
