OLD:

SECTION I - Membership

- B. An intended member who is not a charter member is termed an applicant. An applicant must:
 - 1. Be invited and sponsored by an active member of the club in good standing.
 - 2. Attend at least two meetings of the club by invitation of an active member.
 - Submit a written application of membership.
 - 4. Take no less than three ski trips in the company of members.
 - 5. Pass the USSA Uniform Basic Ski Test or equivalent.

PROPOSED:

SECTION I - Membership

- B. An intended member who is not a charter member is termed an applicant. An applicant must:
 - 1. Be invited and sponsored by an active member of the club in good standing.
 - 2. Submit a written application of membership together with dues.
 - 3. No application may be acted upon by the membership committee for active membership until the following provisions have been met.
 - a. have attended at least two meetings of the club.
 - b. have taken at least three ski trips in the company of member(s).
 - c. have passed the USSA Uniform Basic Ski Test or an equivalent.
